Gilbert, Wilshire, Liberty, Marquette, Pershing, Erma and Leland Improvements Construction Update #7A June 29, 2015

June 29, 2015:

This update is being distributed only to homes along the east side of Leland and north side of Wilshire.

On Tuesday, June 30th, curb and gutter is scheduled to be poured on the **north side of Wilshire between Victory and IL 251, and east side of Leland between Wilson and Pershing. The pour along the east side of Leland may stop at Marquette, depending on contractor progress.**

We ask that you please have your vehicle out of your driveway by 7:00 A.M the day of the pour. It typically takes 2-4 days for the concrete to cure to a sufficient strength to support traffic, so you will not have vehicular access to your driveways during that time. You will need to park on the opposite side of the road if you need access to your vehicle while the curb is curing. Parking and working space will be tight during the curb and gutter construction, and you might want to check to see if your neighbors on the opposite side of the street will allow you to park in their driveways. You will have the chance to return the favor when the curb construction shifts to the opposite side of the street. As a reminder, the Contractor will backfill a small portion (3-4 feet wide) of the new curb the day after it is poured to make it easier to walk over. They will backfill the remainder of the curb once it has cured to sufficient strength to support traffic.
