

Here is the update for the upcoming week (8/3/15):

IL 173

On Monday, the center lanes of Alpine Road will close south of IL 173 and crews will be on site to place brick in the center median of Alpine Road south of IL 173. This work is expected to last 3-4 days, and once complete, crews will move to the intersection of Smythe Avenue and Ralston road to place brick in the triangular median on the south side of Ralston Road.

As a reminder, traffic control will remain in place along IL 173 generally between Perryville Road and Forest Hills Road for the duration of the construction season. Traffic control will also remain in place within certain turn lanes of Forest Hills and Perryville Roads.

IL 173 - East of Perryville Road

The Contractor will continue grading operations behind the new curbing, and landscape crews will be on site to begin placing brick in the center medians. The Contractor is paving Mitchell Road, and expects to have the Mitchell Road paving complete on August 3rd, and Mitchell Road will be reopened to Anajli Way in order to provide a more direct access route to Perryville Road for the residents who reside at the southern end of Mitchell Road.

Looking Ahead.....

Exciting news.....the Contractor plans to shift traffic to the new pavement on or about August 10th. The Mitchell Road/IL 173 intersection will reopen to traffic at that time, and the Contractor will start to reconstruct the eastbound lanes of IL 173.
