Alpine Road West Service Drive Reconstruction Construction Update #6A September 18, 2015

Week of September 21st:

- The Contractor is currently working on improvements at the intersection of Story Book Lane and Alpine Road. This work is tentatively scheduled to be completed next week, weather permitting.
- The Contractor has completed the majority of drainage improvements along the west side of Alpine Road. In the next couple of weeks, the Contractor will return in those areas to finish grading and restoration. These drainage improvements are being completed now in preparation for the shared-use path improvements, which will be constructed in 2016.
- The Contractor is scheduled to begin driveway apron improvements along the west side of Alpine Road from Story Book Lane to Roosevelt Road, starting at Story Book Lane. Their scope of work will consist of constructing an 8-foot wide concrete path across your driveway apron, which will be part of the future shared-use path along the west side of Alpine Road. The remaining portion of your driveway that is disturbed during this work will be replaced with asphalt pavement. Additionally any grass areas disturbed along the sides of your driveway apron will also be restored.
- The Contractor has been instructed to maintain vehicular access at your driveways at the end of each working day. There may be instances where the Contractor constructs a temporary driving surface with stone adjacent to your driveway for your use until these proposed improvements are completed. Other residents have indicated that they plan on sharing driveway access with their nearby neighbor. If you have a nearby neighbor, please discuss the option of sharing each other's driveway during this time. The Contractor and a representative from the Village will be knocking on doors in the next few days to discuss driveway access with each Owner/occupant.
- Please expect some temporary lane closures along Alpine Road during this time.
