

IL 173-Alpine Road to Perryville Road

We are very happy to report that the sod has been placed, and the the work along IL 173 (*and associated side streets*) between Forest Hills and Alpine Road is substantially complete. However, there will be a few "punch list" items that the Contractor will be working on from time to time, and there may be temporary lane closures for the punch list items. One of the more major "punch list" items is to seal the joints in the new concrete pavement, and there will be a moving lane closure for this operation. There is a chance that the joint filling work could begin late the week of October 5th; however, it appears that the majority of this work will occur the week of October 12th.

As a reminder, traffic control will remain in place along IL 173 generally between Perryville Road and Forest Hills Road for the duration of the construction season. Traffic control will also remain in place within certain turn lanes of Forest Hills and Perryville Roads.

IL 173-East of Perryville

The Contractor will be making final preparation of the stone base for pavement. Paving operations are scheduled to resume the week of October 12th; however, it is possible that paving operations could begin late the week of October 5th.

The Contractor will also begin final seeding and restoration of the north side of IL 173 during the week of October 5th.
