

IL 173-Alpine Road to Perryville Road

Crews will be on site throughout the week to finish crack filling along IL 173 between Alpine and Perryville Roads. The crack filling will take place as a "moving operation", meaning that lane closures will be in place only in the immediate work area.

IL 173-East of Perryville

The Eastbound Lanes have opened!! The Contractor has opened the southern eastbound lane to traffic, and the center lanes of IL 173 will remain closed throughout the week so that the contractor can remove the crossovers, and construct the remainder of the median improvements for the center median immediately east of Perryville Road. The contractor will also remove the crossover and complete the center median improvements at the far east end of the project, and landscaping work on the remainder center medians will continue through the week of November 9th. Crews will also continue to landscape on the north side of IL 173 east of Mitchell Road.

Pavement marking crews will be on site this weekend to place the pavement markings on IL 173 east of Perryville, and it is anticipated that the majority of the markings will be in place by November 9th.

The signals at the intersection of Mitchell Road & IL 173 have gone live, and there is now a dedicated left turn lane for the eastbound traffic at the Mitchell Road intersection.

Forest Hills and Perryville Roads

The Contractor has replaced the cracked panels on Perryville Road, and it is expected that the thru lanes of Perryville Road will reopen to traffic by November 9th. Traffic control will remain in place in certain turn lanes of Perryville Road and Forest Hills Roads throughout the week.
