### **Kingsley & Drexel Improvements Construction Update #4 July 22, 2016**

#### **Week of July 25<sup>th</sup>:**

- The Contractor will remove the curbing on both sides of the road in the 700 block of Drexel. This work is scheduled for Monday, weather permitting. For the affected residents, there will be a short time (about 20 minutes +/-) where you will not have access to your driveway while the curb is removed.
- The Contractor plans to start storm sewer work at the intersection of Drexel/Elkhorn and will continue east towards Elm Avenue. The work is currently scheduled to begin on Tuesday. The construction will occupy the entire roadway, so you will need to access your drive from a different direction during this construction. Driveway access will be blocked when the Contractor is working in front of your home, and the Contractor will notify affected residents the day before the work blocks access to the driveway. The Contractor may also need to adjust the water service and sanitary sewer service that connects your home to the main pipes in the street. If this occurs, you will not have water/sewer service during the time that the Contractor is making the adjustments. Again, the Contractor will notify you of these items the day before the work occurs.
- If you have received a temporary construction easement form, please fill it out and return it to the offices of McMahon Associates, 1700 Hutchins Road, Machesney Park, IL. Our office is located on the west side of the new Meijer Store and you are more than welcome to simply drop the forms off at our office. We are open from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday thru Friday.
- We were advised that the Post Office accidentally delivered mail to the mailboxes at your homes on Tuesday, July 19<sup>th</sup>. We therefore suggest that you check your mailbox at your home for mail. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.
