Kingsley & Drexel Improvements Construction Update #6 August 5, 2016

Week of August 8th:

- The Contractor will continue storm sewer work on Drexel. Storm sewer construction will continue east towards Elm Avenue. The construction will occupy the entire roadway, so you will need to access your drive from a different direction during this construction. Driveway access will be blocked when the Contractor is working in front of your home, and the Contractor will notify affected residents the day before the work blocks access to the driveway. The Contractor may also need to adjust the water service and sanitary sewer service that connects your home to the main pipes in the street. If this occurs, you will not have water/sewer service during the time that the Contractor is making the adjustments. Again, the Contractor will notify you of these items the day before the work occurs.
- If you have received a temporary construction easement form, please fill it out and return it to the offices of McMahon Associates, 1700 Hutchins Road, Machesney Park, IL. Our office is located on the west side of the new Meijer Store and you are more than welcome to simply drop the forms off at our office. We are open from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday thru Friday. Time is running out to get the forms in, so we urge you to do so at your earliest possible convenience.
