



## **Alpine Road, Burden Road and Marlin Drive Improvements**

TO: All Businesses on Alpine Road

On Monday, September 11<sup>th</sup>:

- The Contractor will be closing the intersection of Burden Road and Marlin Drive in order to widen the intersection. AT&T needs to relocate some of its facilities around the intersection as well, and AT&T's work will be completed concurrently with the widening. If all goes as planned, the intersection will reopen on or about September 24<sup>th</sup>. Detour routes will be marked during the closure.
- The Contractor will begin to remove the pavement from the asphalt driveway approaches by using a milling process. We expect that the milling of the driveway approaches will take one to two days to complete. The driveways will be accessible to traffic after the milling is complete, and there will be a 1.5 inch "bump" which will remain in place until the new driveway surface is constructed.

Over the next 2-3 weeks, the Contractor will be replacing the curbing around the driveway approaches, and will be replacing the concrete driveway aprons as well. Weather permitting, we should be placing the final surface on Alpine Road, the intersections and driveways the first week of October.
