



Alpine Road, Burden Road and Marlin Drive Improvements

TO: All Businesses on Alpine Road

- Monday, October 2nd: The Contractor will be placing paving fabric on Alpine Road, and the intersections of Burden/Alpine, Burden/Marlin, & Marlin/IL 251. The fabric will be secured in place by a “tack coat” of bituminous materials. When the contractor places the tack coat, fresh oil signs will be up and if needed the contractor will sprinkle a light coating of sand to minimize tracking of the tack coat. While the tack coat may be driven on after placement, it takes a few hours to dry and we caution vehicles to **drive very slowly** during this time to limit splattering on vehicles.
- Tuesday/Wednesday October 3rd and 4th: The Contractor will be paving the final asphalt surface on Alpine Road and the intersections. One lane of traffic will be paved at a time, and flaggers will be present to direct traffic around the work zone. Access to each individual driveway will be restricted for approximately 20 minutes as the pavement is placed immediately in front of the driveway. The driveway approaches will be paved after the main line paving is complete. Most of the driveway approaches can be paved in a half hour or less.
- Once paving is complete, crews will be in to add shoulder stone and place the new pavement markings. We expect the shoulder stone and pavement marking work to be complete by October 10th. This work will be done under traffic and with flagging crews as necessary.
