Scott, Juniper and Cadet Improvements Construction Update #10A September 25, 2018

This update is being distributed only to the homes located on Scott Lane between Juniper and Heron, and Juniper Lane between Mildred and Cameo.

Curbing will be installed along the west side (even address side) of Scott Lane between Juniper and Heron on Wednesday, September 26th. Curbing will also be installed along both sides of Juniper Lane between Mildred and Cameo on Wednesday September 26th. We ask that you please have your vehicle out of your driveway by 7:00 A.M the day of the pour, and you may park on the opposite side of the road (Juniper residents should park on Cameo or Mildred). It typically takes 2-4 days for the concrete to cure to a sufficient strength to support traffic, so you will not have vehicular access to your driveways during that time. You will need to continue to park in the road if you need access to your vehicle while the curb is curing. The Contractor will backfill a small portion (3-4 feet wide) of the new curb the day after is poured to make it easier to walk over. We will begin to test the curb strength on Thursday, and the Contractor will backfill the driveways once the curb has cured to sufficient strength to support traffic.
